Summer Camp 2021

Welcome to GLSA's summer program! During the summer, GLSA operates an all-day program for children entering kindergarten through the summer after 5th grade. Our hours of operation are 8:00AM-6:00PM. Each week of this year's nine-week summer program has a theme in which we will organize our activities. Children will have the choice whether to participate in teacher lead activities throughout the day or do their own activity in a structured environment with the wealth of toys and resources we have for their use.

****Please note– Our program will be operating under Washington State's Department of Health Covid-19 Safety Guidelines for childcares and summer camps until the Covid-19 crisis has passed. Our structure, enrollment and activities will be designed to conform to these guidelines. Wednesday fieldtrips will be put on hold until we learn more but will be added if restrictions are lifted by summer 2021. For the time being we plan on doing field days on Wednesdays.***

Week 1: "Lights, Camera, Action!" (6/28-7/2) This week will be full of performing, singing, dancing, and showing off all your talents! We will be performing skits, making music videos, making movie posters, playing movie trivia, drama games, charades, and of course having our own dress up fashion show.

Week 2: "Art Explosion!" (7/5-7/9) Join us for a fun week of art exploration and creation! We will be doing activities using many different art materials and incorporate the styles of various artists. Some activities for the week will include paper mache, splatter art, melted crayon art, collages, self-portraits, creating still life, and more.

Week 3: "The Real Kids of Green Lake" (7/12-7/16) We will take inspiration for activities this week from reality tv. We will do kid friendly versions of "Project Runway", "Fear Factor", "Survivor", "Minute to Win It", and "GLSA Jeopardy". Be ready for a friendly competition as we put our skills to the test!

Week 4: "Celebrating the Seasons" (7/19-7/23) Be ready for a change in season as we celebrate winter in July! We will spend half the week making our own snow globes, having a 'snowball' fight, decorating snowflakes and making home made hot chocolate. The second half of the week will be our own "Tropical Vacation" where children will make flower leis, learn how to hula dance, spend time at Green Lake Beach, find and decorate seashells, and end the week with a GLSA water balloon fight.

Week 5: "Classic Camp Week" (7/26-7/30) It's an oldie but a goodie! Join us for classic camp week as we take our inspiration from summer camps in the 60's! We will learn classic camp songs, paint pet rocks, make lanyards, play capture the flag, make s'mores, get messy with an egg and water balloon toss, make our own relay races, and make dream catchers.

Week 6: “Wild Things” (8/2-8/6) Animals and all things wild is our theme this week. A few of our activities will be making nature notebooks to record children’s experiences and observations for the week, have a wild rumpus dance, make masks and tails, play the “web of life” and “what animal am I” games, creating bug houses for the garden, make animal puppets, play bug bingo, and more.

Week 7: “Mad Science!” (8/9-8/13) Get ready for some weird and wacky science! Each day will be a different experiment. We will see what happens when we put mentos in Coca Cola, making our own home-made lava lamps, making rock candy out of sugar crystals, making our own balloon rockets, and much more!

Week 8: “Planet Earth” (8/16-8/20) It’s GLSA’s earth week! We will spend time in nature as we play at the beach, walk around Green Lake, and enjoy some great outdoors. Some other activities will include making lavender cloud dough, creating our own bug habitats, making bird feeders, creating recycled art, and getting your face painted like your favorite animal.

Week 9: “Adventure of the Ages” (8/23-8/27) Every day a new adventure through the ages! We will be celebrating “Castles, Kings, and Medieval Things” where we will build cardboard castles, and go on our famous GLSA “dungeon tours”. Explore “Greek Mythology” where we will learn about the Greek God’s and Goddesses. Investigate the “Dawn of the Dinosaurs” where we will make dinosaur footprints and observe dinosaur eggs. Lastly, “Pirate Day” where children will go on a treasure hunt, make eye patches and pirate hats, dig for hidden treasure and much more!

Registration: Please follow the summer registration directions given on our website at www.greenlakechildcare.org or request registration paperwork from the GLSA office. As soon as we have received your completed paperwork we will contact you to confirm your days or wait list status. Completed paperwork includes the new or returning registration form (which you can fill out online on our website), the summer packet which includes the summer dates you are requesting (must be scanned and emailed or may be mailed), an immunization record on the form provided or any updates to the immunization form we have on file and, if this is your first GLSA registration, a \$35 check.

- ◆ Tuition and field trip fees if any for weeks 6 to 10 (8/2-8/27) are due Monday, July 26th
- ◆ Please note that you are responsible for payment for all dates and field trip costs not dropped via email by the drop deadline. Please do not consider yourself dropped until you receive a confirmation email.

The drop deadline for all summer dates is Monday, May 17th.

- ◆ GLSA will be closed on Monday, July 5th so the full time rate for week one is \$322
